For almost four decades, Benthem Crowwel Architects has been creating innovative, flexible and efficient designs in a variety of scales: from universities, museums, bridges, railway stations, metro lines, offices, housing, malls and urban plans to bicycle tunnels, design projects and tiny houses. In all designs, BNTHMCRWL seeks a balance between economic, social and ecological interests, with a particular focus on innovation and sustainability.

Today the studio has seven partners: Jan Benthem, Mels Crowwel, Joost Vos, Marten Wassmann, Pascal Cornips, Daniel Jongtien and Saartje van der Made. BNTHMCRWL employs some seventy staff: an international team of highly experienced architects, engineers, young trainees and recently graduated designers, who work together on various projects from offices in the Netherlands, Germany, France and the US.

Well known buildings are: Stedelijk Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art, Anne Frank House, Amsterdam Airport Schiphol, Ziggo Dome, RAI Convention and Exhibition Centre Amsterdam, North/South-metro line in Amsterdam, four metro stations in Paris, and high speed railway stations Amsterdam, Rotterdam, The Hague and Utrecht.
